



Drinks List

As was the case with their neighbours in the Lowlands, Highlanders did not restrict their wine drinking to happy, joyful occasions. On the contrary, no funeral of laird or gentleman took place without plentiful supplies of good cheer for those who attended. The funeral of Sir Alexander MacDonald of Sleat in 1746 was no exception – the largesse accompanying the ceremony having reputedly cost his estate £2,645. With so much wine flowing, this solemn event soon degenerated into riotous merry-making. In the brawling which ensued, many were seriously injured. Comparing it to a similar event some time afterwards, MacDonald of Ord remarked:

“There has not been a funeral like it since that of Sir Alexander MacDonald when three men were killed and 50 taken out of the churchyard with the breath just left in them.”

At funerals where such quantities of wine were being lavishly dispensed, there was a real danger that the reverence of the occasion would be forgotten and important details of the funeral arrangements be over-looked.

Taste: Vanilla, toffee and light fruitcake aromas with gentle peat smoke. hints of sea salt intertwine with zesty lemon and sweet candied lime. Licorice notes evolve into a smouldering finish .

Taste: Dry sherry aromas mingle with stewed raisin and roasted hazelnut, complemented by a citrus edge. Creamy milk chocolate and orange zest flavours lead to spiced stewed fruits. The finish is fruity with lingering citrus.

Benromach 21 Year Old – Speyside **£22.00**

Taste: The first-fill sherry and bourbon influence is paramount on the nose and on the palate. Sherry at the fore with rich citric fruit, particularly orange, and tree fruits. A drying spice gives the mouthfeel dimension, with soft berries, oak, light pepper, and more citrus playing toward the finish. A sweet pinch of smoke follows, resting on soft oak notes.

Balvenie 21 Year Old Port Cask – Speyside **£36.00**

Taste: On the nose, a perfume of fruity and ripe raisin notes, backed by a nutty dryness. Refined with remarkable character, it is creamy and silky with fruit, honey and spice notes, with a long, gentle, nutty finish.

Linkwood 25 Year Old – Speyside **£29.00**

Taste: A flavoursome package of ripe and stewed fruit, floral and slightly nutty. It's made the most of its sherry finish, relaxed and poised with a medium to full body, but isn't overly boisterous. Citric mocha on the finish. Great for all occasions!
